This Chart was traced at Carmel, California Nov 28th 1938 by Arthur Stedman from a Chart in the family of Gen. William Randolph Stedman of Palo Alto, Calif., whose Grandfather James was the son of Adam Stedman and Elizabeth Adie shown above as direct descendants of Robert Stedman of Kinross.

This Chart was copied at Pointe a Pierre, Trinidad, West Indies, and the West Indian section of the Stedman Another family descended from David Stedman and Eliza Adie, was brought up to date. It was copied by Marion Stedman, Harris (nee Archer) and brought up to date in August 1937. Our family copies of this chart were destroyed in Dominica, when Maxwell House was burnt in 1957.
